

## **CONSTITUTION**

1. The name of the Society is “**Society of Pacific Region Fishery Officers**”.
2. The purposes of the Society are:
  - a) To maintain an association of Fishery Officers within the Province of British Columbia and the Yukon Territory to promote their interests;
  - b) To promote, encourage and effect education training, and achievements of the members of the Society in all matters relating to or affecting their vocation;
  - c) To endeavor to secure a greater degree of recognition in their vocation for members of the Society;
  - d) To promote benevolence, and to encourage Society members to maintain the highest level of professionalism and respect the views and interests of others.
3. The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in the Province of British Columbia and the Yukon Territory. This provision is unalterable.
4. In the event that the Society should at any time be wound up or dissolved, the remaining assets after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be turned over to a recognized charitable organization in the Province or elsewhere in Canada as directed by the members. This provision is unalterable.
